What is SUB-MERGE?

SUB-MERGE is an ongoing project combining art, technology and mental health awareness.

This print sale offers artworks donated by 24 artists for £100 plus postage and packaging with 100% of profits going to Mind.

Who is hosting this project?

Emulsion, creative studio and magazine based in London, UK.

Where will the profits be going and why?

All profits raised will go to Mind - the UK-wide charity. Our project aims to broaden knowledge of mental health and help remove barriers of access to support. This is why we've chosen Mind which campaigns to improve services, raise awareness, and promote understanding of mental health problems.

Do you ship the prints internationally?

Yes, we post all prints internationally. Prices available on checkout.

When will I receive my prints?

All prints ordered within the UK before the 16th of December should be received before Christmas. All international orders will be received within 3 weeks of purchase. Unfortunately, we cannot 100% guarantee this because of Covid-19.

Can you rush my shipping?

All prints are sent Royal Mail 1st Class, Tracked and Signed.

What's your return policy?

No returns are accepted, unless lost or damaged in the post.

Is there a border on the prints?

All prints are set on 12"x16" sized paper with a white border. The prints are not full bleed.

Are they limited edition?

The prints are not limited in number, however they will only be available between the 7-16th of December, 2020.

Are the prints signed?

Due to Covid 19, this was not possible.

What type of paper are the prints?

The paper & print techniques are specific to the artwork, please see individual item for more info.
